


2013 RESULTS OF THE ADVANCED PLACEMENT® (AP®) EXAMINATIONS

Advanced Placement Results

Since 1984, each school district in South Carolina has been required to provide Advanced Placement® (AP®) courses in all secondary schools that include grade eleven or twelve. These classes prepare students for the national AP examinations. Students who score 3, 4, or 5 on an AP exam are, in many instances, considered qualified to receive credit for the equivalent course(s) at colleges and universities that give credit for AP exams. The data in this document are presented for high school students who participated in AP courses in the state's public schools and took at least one AP exam during the 2012–2013 school year.





The percentage of examinations with scores of 3 or higher for South Carolina public school students in 2013 was 57 percent (21,136 out of 37,226). For the nation, during the same period, the percentage of examinations with scores of 3 or higher for public school students was 57 percent. The number of exams taken in South Carolina public schools rose from 34,086 in 2012 to 37,226 in 2013, an increase of 9.2 percent, and the number of test-takers rose from 21,429 in 2012 to 23,442 in 2013, an increase of 9.4 percent.

Data used to compile this report were provided by The College Board in September 2013. This report does not reflect any changes the College Board may have made after September 2013.

The following chart provides information on the number of AP exams taken, the number of exams with scores of 3 to 5, and the number of public school students taking exams in South Carolina public schools during the past three years.



In 2013, 23,442 South Carolina public school students took 37,226 exams in 31 AP exam areas (students could take more than one test). The six most-taken AP exams were, in order, English Language and Composition, United States History, English Literature and Composition, Human Geography, Calculus AB, and Statistics.

In 2013, 54 percent of the 20,769 exams taken by 13,337 female public school students in South Carolina received scores of 3 to 5; 60 percent of the 16,379 exams taken by 10,079 male public school students received scores of 3 to 5; 31 percent of exams taken by 3,162 African American public school students received scores of 3 to 5; and 61 percent of exams taken by 17,079 white public school students received scores of 3 to 5.

The following table provides information in alphabetical order on the AP exams that were taken by South Carolina public school students in 2013, the numbers of 3 to 5 scores, and the percentages of 3 to 5 scores. The SC Department of Education does not provide performance data (--) for subgroups smaller than five in the scores category.
