


How Can Enrich Help You With SLOs?

Enrich Assess supports the Student Learning Objectives (SLO) process for teachers and administrators in South Carolina. Here are some of the tasks you can perform using the Enrich system already in place within your district.

Track each teacher's progression in the SLO process

SLOs have a status that can indicate if they are in draft, if required conferences were held, if revisions are needed, or if the SLO was approved. The statuses can be customized by your district to match your workflow.



Complete the target statement and select the students to be included in the SLO. Text fields follow the SCDE Templates.



Easily Add Students to the SLO

Enrich already has your students and rosters, so selecting one or more classes for your SLO is easy. Individual students can be excluded with a documented reason.



Lock and Unlock SLOs

Once a teacher has satisfactorily completed his/her SLO plan, you can lock the SLO from further edits. Later, you can unlock the SLO for mid-year revisions if needed.


