High School Mathematics Professional Learning Opportunity: Foundations in Algebra and Intermediate Algebra

The **Office of Standards and Learning** is hosting **free** regional professional learning opportunities focusing on our state’s new high school **Foundations in Algebra** and **Intermediate Algebra** courses in three locations around the state. The goal of each session is to provide high school mathematics teachers, administrators responsible for mathematics curricula, and district mathematics supervisors with conceptual understandings and skills needed to successfully implement the South Carolina College and Career-Ready Standards for Mathematics in **Foundations in Algebra** and **Intermediate Algebra**. Participants will primarily engage in the **Foundations in Algebra** and **Intermediate Algebra** standards that are also located in Algebra 2 and Probability and Statistics. ESOL, CATE, and Exceptional Children educators are also invited to register and participate. By the conclusion of each session, all participants will have instructional materials and resources aligned to standards in both courses. Upon the completion of this professional learning opportunity, participants will receive a **Certificate of Recognition** and **six contact hours**.
