Constitutional and Statutory Provisions:

Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended: §59-5-10. *"The Board shall select its [chair] and other officers to serve for such terms as the Board may designate. Provided, the Superintendent of Education shall serve as secretary and administrative officer to the Board. The Board shall adopt its own rules and procedures. The [chair] and other officers shall have such powers and duties as may be determined by the Board not inconsistent with the law."*

State Board Rule:

Officers of the State Board of Education shall consist of three persons: the Chair, the Chair-Elect, and the Secretary who, by provisions of §59-3-30 (South Carolina Code) shall be the State Superintendent of Education.

The term of the Chair shall be limited to one year, unless the Chair-Elect becomes Chair due to the resignation of the Chair prior to the expiration of the Chair's term. In that case, the Chair-Elect will serve as Chair for the remainder of that year, plus the normal one year term.
