

## 2014-15 Gifted and Talented Endorsement Graduate Courses

Enrollment for teachers is based on priority and need. The priorities are described for each course in the table below. To request a space in the course, eligible teachers must complete and email the course pre-registration form, with all information **“AND” have their principal send an email that verifies their priority level** as Priority 1, 2, or 3. ### **Seating Priorities for EDFS 760 and 761:**

Note that the endorsement level (the Nature and Needs of Gifted and Talented Learners and Introduction to Curriculum for Gifted and Talented Learners) courses have a seating priority. Students will be enrolled by the first priority, then second, and then third priority.

**Priority 1** (highest level)—teachers who have already completed one of the two endorsement classes and who are currently teaching GT students.

**Priority 2** (middle level)—teachers who are currently teaching GT students and who have not taken a class or those who have completed one class and are assigned to teach GT students for the upcoming year.

**Priority 3** (lowest level)—teachers who have not completed any courses but who are assigned to teach GT students for the upcoming semester or school year.

**Once students with these priorities are accepted, if open seats remain in the class, the College of Charleston may then enroll other students.**
