

Attitude Lesson Plan

Career Standards & Competencies:

Core Class Competencies:

Task: Learn how our attitudes affect our relationship with other students, parents, teachers, and employers

Grade(s): 6 – 8

Time for lesson plan: 45 minutes

Time allotment	Activity
5 minutes	Allow students to define “attitude” on the acrostic (word document)
10 minutes	Allow students to divide into small groups and prepare a dramatic presentation about students with attitudes <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) one group prepare a drama between peers 2) one group prepare a drama between a student and the parent 3) one group prepare a drama between a student and a teacher 4) one group prepare a drama between an employee and employer
30	Discuss the vignettes and who had an attitude and how an attitude (good or bad) can impact our relationships
Alternate activity or can be used with the above activity over 2 days or for a longer class period	Use the Employer’s Expectations sheet (pdf document) to allow students to circle the areas in which our attitude plays a role in our employment. Count the number of times an action related to our attitude is circled and decide if attitude is more of an entry, mid or high level expectation

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
