TITLE: WEBSITE SCAVENGER HUNT

SUBJECT: Guidance Activity

GRADE LEVEL(S): 6-8

Lesson Objectives

1. Students will demonstrate the ability to access career resources on the Internet.

Assessment

1. Students will accurately complete the *Website Scavenger Hunt* worksheet.

Preparation

- Prior Learning—Skills to access the Internet and selected websites
- Handouts/Worksheets— *Website Scavenger Hunt* worksheet
- Resources—Computers with Internet access, career information websites
- Time Required—45 minutes in computer lab

Procedures

Part One

- Make arrangements for the class to visit the computer lab.

Part Two (45 minutes)

- Engage students in a quick brainstorm of resources they could use get career information.
- Point out to them that the Internet is an excellent resource for career information.
- Hand out the *Website Scavenger Hunt* worksheet and review it with the students.
- Tell students they have 20 minutes to complete the scavenger hunt.
- Engage the students in a discussion of what they learned.
- Review the 16 clusters with the students. Have them determine if the websites they explored addressed careers related to one specific cluster, several clusters, or all 16 clusters.
