

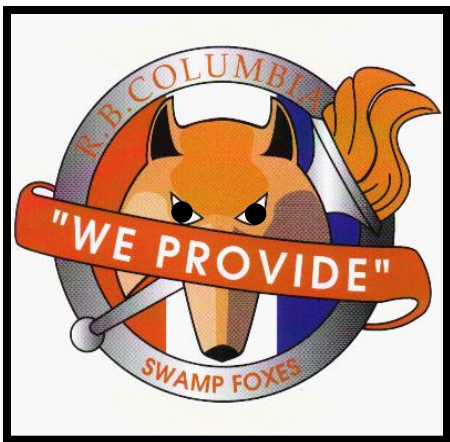

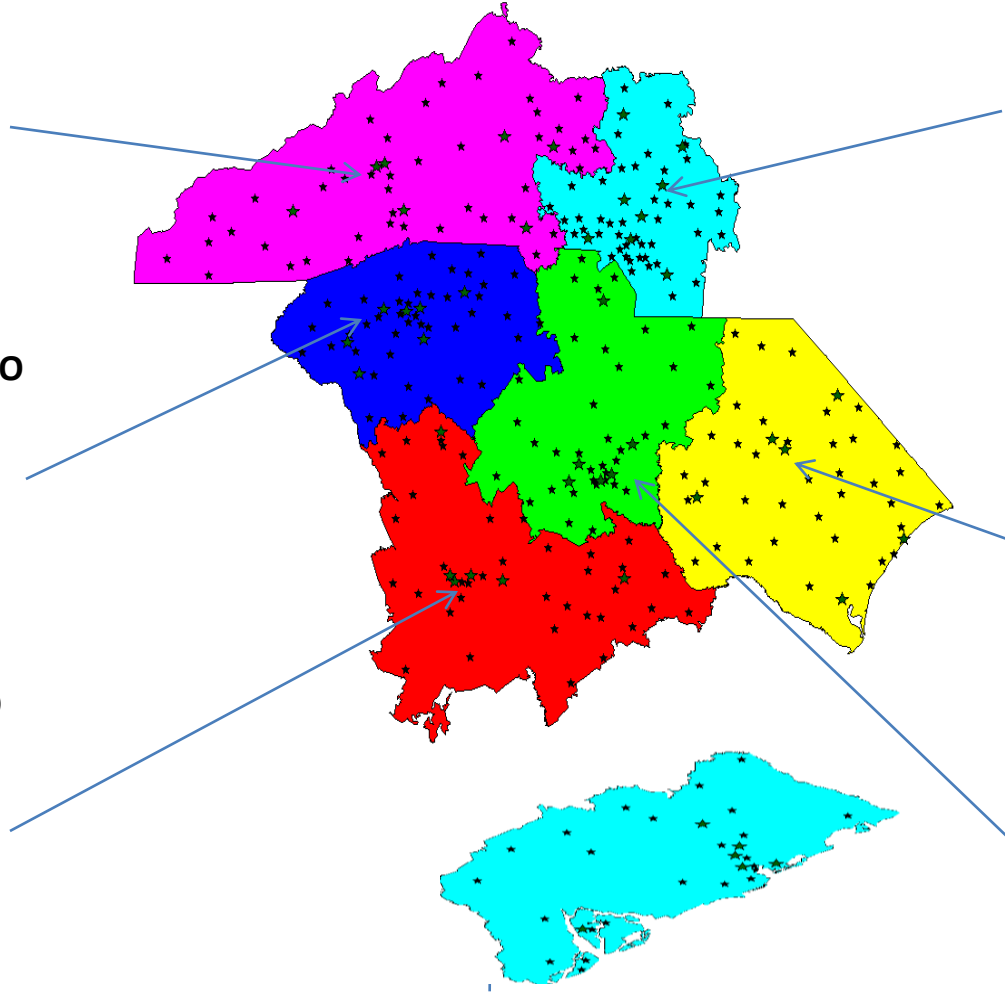

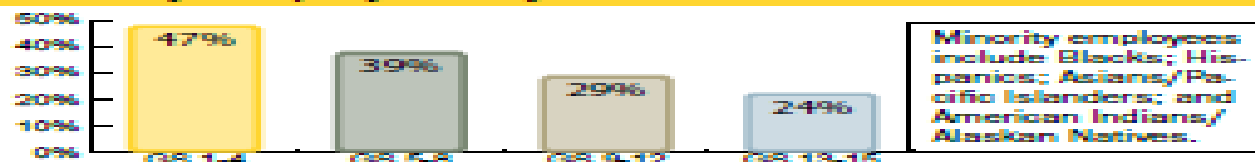

US ARMY CIVILIANS

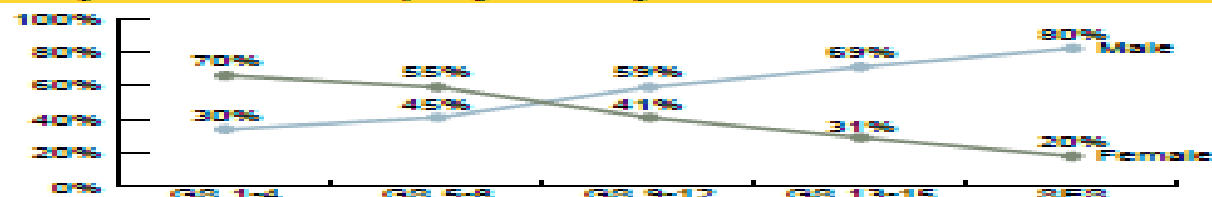
ARMY CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES (Excludes National Guard)

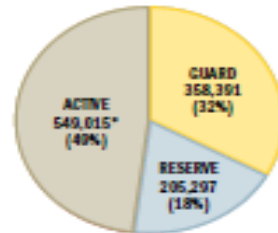

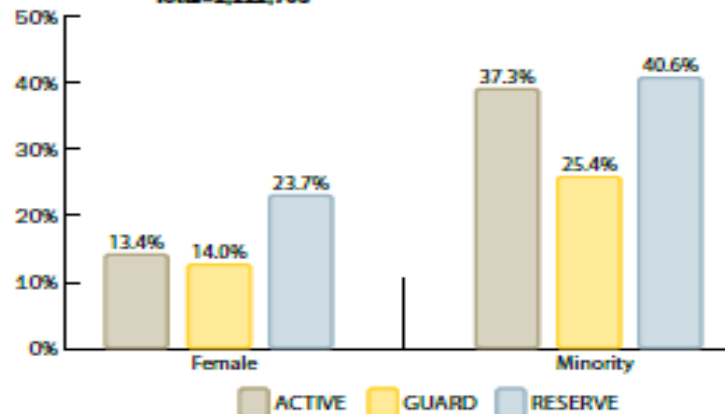
TOTAL ARMY

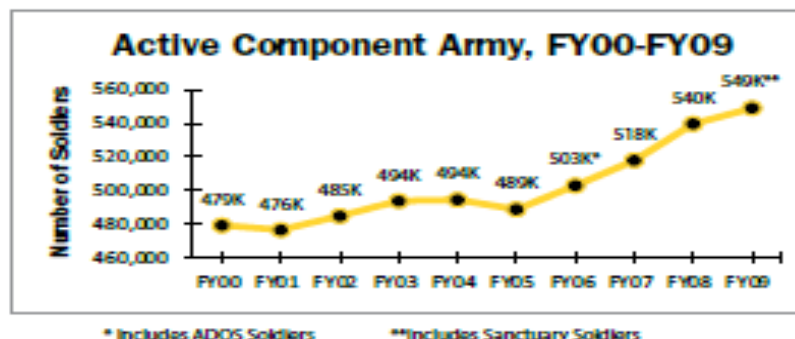

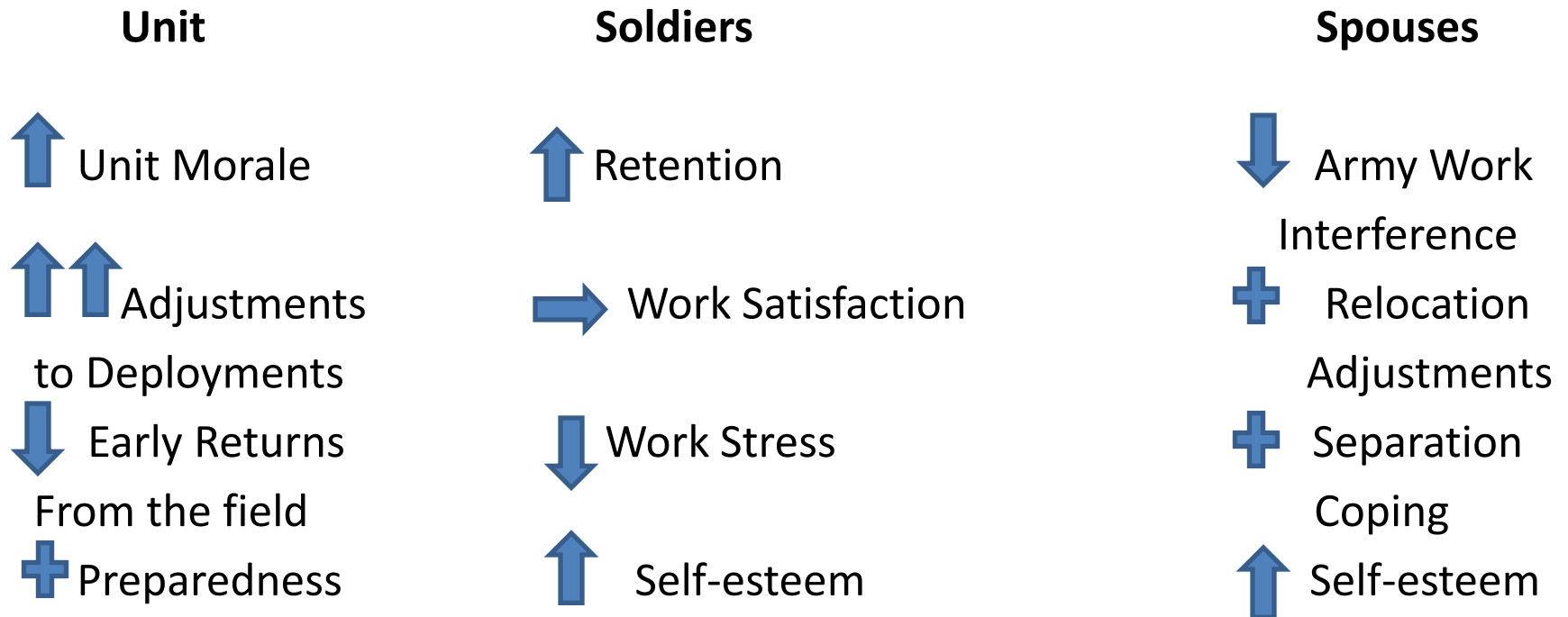
