REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT

I am thankful for the students, parents, faculty, and staff of Ninety Six for their dedication and hard work which has helped make our district so successful. Our Board of Trustees gives many hours of service to the school district, without compensation, in order to provide the students and staff in our district with an exemplary educational experience.

The Ninety Six School District strives to cultivate well rounded students and citizens that will enter the workforce well prepared. It is our desire to provide students with the tools needed to meet the demands of life today, whether that means college, technical college, military, or the immediate work force experience.

The total educational experience in our district consists of outstanding academic, athletic, artistic, vocational, and extracurricular activities.

This year, our schools have been recognized for many honors, including scoring above the state average on the majority of the PACT tests. On the SAT, our students gained two points on the Mean Composite Score. The district score of 95.2 was the highest compliance index in the state on the AYP report. Ninety Six High School made Excellent on the report card for the third year, Edgewood Middle made Average for the fourth year, Ninety Six Elementary made Good for the fifth year, and Ninety Six Primary made Excellent for the fifth year.

The percentage for passing the HSAP on the first attempt was 89.9% and Ninety Six High School was ranked as one of the 15 best high schools in the state by U.S. News and World Report. Ninety Six Elementary School was awarded the honor of being one of 116 schools, out of 866 elementary schools, for Closing The Gap by the SC State Department of Education. Five students qualified for the first Work Ethic Certificate program at the Career Center.

We will continue our journey of continuous improvement and strive to provide an excellent educational experience for all students.
