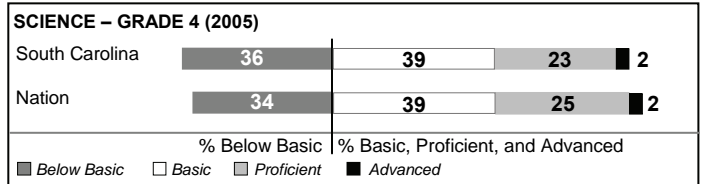
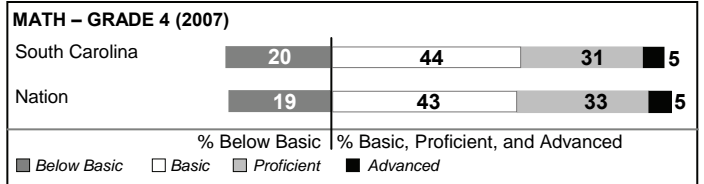
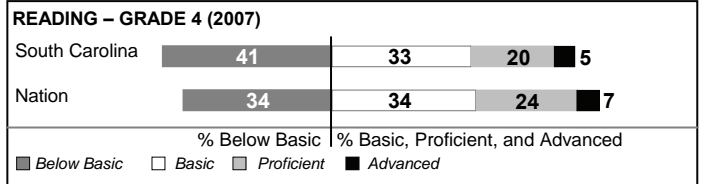
PASS PERFORMANCE

REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Our goal for several years has been for every student to be successful, and we are pleased to report that we are seeing improvement in test scores. We received the Palmetto Silver Award for improvement in PACT scores last year. MAP scores last year also improved, with more than 58% of our tested students achieving the NWEA targeted growth. The goal was 50%.

This year we have implemented new ideas into our curriculum, especially in math, and are anxious to see continued improvement in scores.

Parental and community support continues to give us the extra hands. We need to ensure success for every student.
