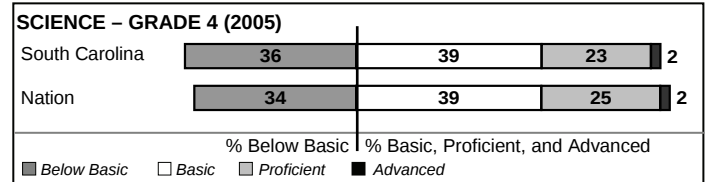
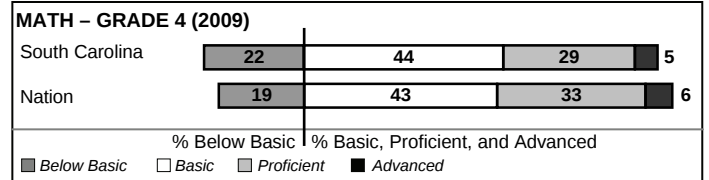
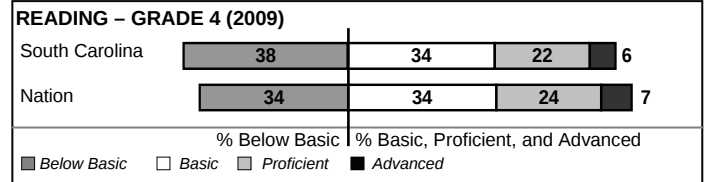
PASS PERFORMANCE
