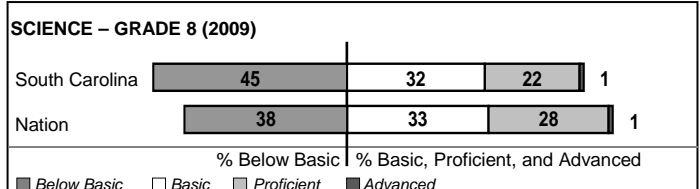
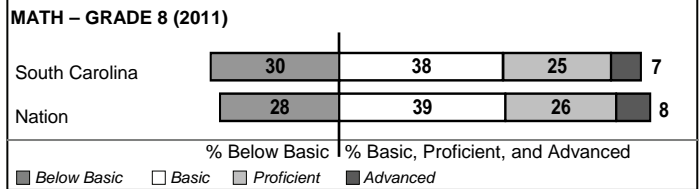
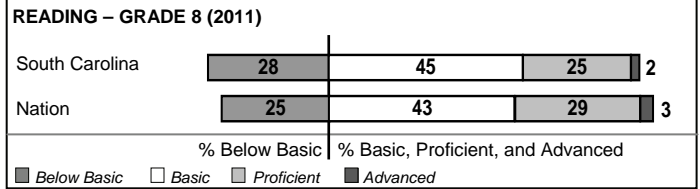
PASS PERFORMANCE
