Kinard Elementary School is located in the heart of Clover, SC serving approximately 370 students from pre-kindergarten to fifth grade. Kinard is committed to providing a positive, educational program that encourages academic success and personal growth to each student.

The academic program at Kinard Elementary provides each child with instruction appropriate to their individual needs. Grade level field trips provide experiences for students to make connections beyond the classroom. Additionally, teachers participate in professional development opportunities within the district and state. Kinard embraces the push-in model where our K-5th grade students benefit from having multiple layers of support throughout their instructional day. Through these efforts Kinard is able to provide an excellent standards-based curriculum program.

Kinard continues to provide leadership opportunities to students through The Leader in Me. This leadership model is built on fundamental skills found in Dr. Stephen Covey's best-selling book, The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People. Students have taken ownership of their learning through the year-long process of maintaining Data Notebooks and participating in student-led conferences. Leadership Assemblies showcase students who have demonstrated the 7 Habits in their everyday school life.

Parent Involvement Events are designed for our parents to participate in the learning their child experiences while at school. Fall Festival, Santa's Secret Workshop, Veteran's Day Celebration, and Fine Arts Festival are a few annual events our parents enjoy. PTO sponsored family events involving local restaurants prove to be family-centered as well.

Kinard Elementary is committed to continuous improvement. We recognize that building relationships and immersing ourselves in our school community will assist our students in building a bridge between home and school. Partnerships with local businesses and civic organizations continue to enhance the instructional day. In July 2012, the South Carolina Department of Education was granted a waiver from several accountability requirements of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). This waiver allowed SC to replace the former pass/fail system with one that utilizes more of the statewide assessments already in place and combine these subject area results with graduation rate (in high schools) to determine if each school met the target or made progress toward the target.
