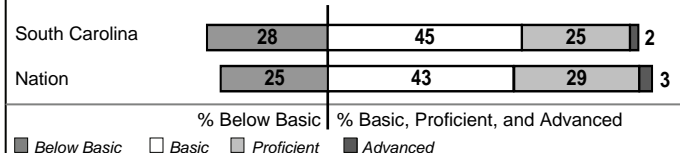
Our School Middle Schools with Students Like Ours Middle schools statewide



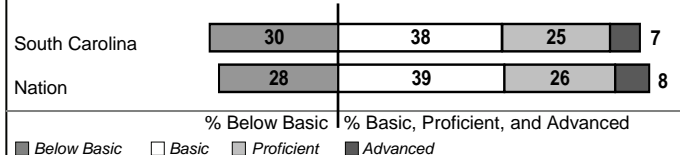

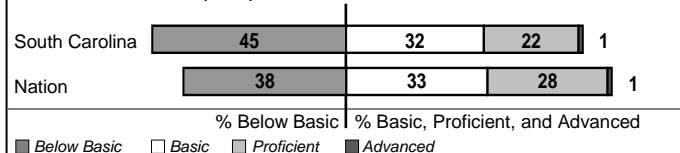
### READING – GRADE 8 (2011)

River Oaks Middle School is located off of Dorchester Road on the border of Dorchester and Charleston counties. We are dedicated to providing a safe environment in order to maximize the academic, creative, athletic, and emotional potential of each student. Our staff of administrators, teachers, guidance counselors, psychologists, teaching assistants, business partners, and community volunteers provides services that allow each of our students the opportunity to reach their full potential. River Oaks Middle School offers a rigorous, relevant, and challenging curriculum that advances the learning of all of our students. River Oaks Middle School is a proud recipient of the Palmetto Silver Award for student achievement for the 2010-2011 school year. Our students continue to progress in all academic areas as evidenced by analyzing our PASS data and our Benchmark data. We have 10 Junior Scholar recipients and several students who have earned state level recognition through the Duke TIP program. River Oaks Middle School students enjoy many opportunities to enhance their educational experience through the arts and electives. We offer classes in piano, guitar, dance, physical education, band, strings, chorus, visual arts, and Spanish. Also, students have the opportunity to participate on QUEST academic teams, NJHS, Robotics, Geography Bee and many other programs. The Bobcat Band had the only Pep Band in the district and played at all home football and basketball games. The Bobcat Jazz Band was started this year and entertained at the District PTSA Awards program. One student qualified for the state competition in the Geography Bee and one of our 6th graders was the Dorchester District Two Spelling Bee Champion. Our Robotics team had a very successful year placing 2nd in our district competition, hosted right here at River Oaks. This qualified the team for the state competition for the 2nd consecutive year. River Oaks Middle School also offers our students a chance to participate in football, volleyball, wrestling, basketball, baseball, and softball. Our seven teams were very successful this year. Volleyball won their 2nd consecutive district championship, winning their final 11 matches. Boys basketball completed a perfect 12-0 season, earning the team the district championship. River Oaks Middle School will continue to meet the challenges of forging a strong relationship with our school community and will strive to provide all students opportunities to maximize their potential as we do things The Bobcat Way.
