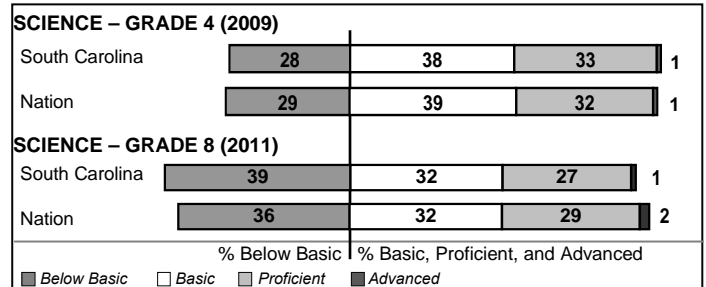
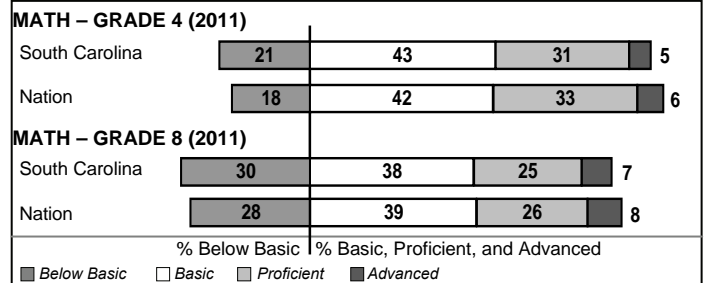
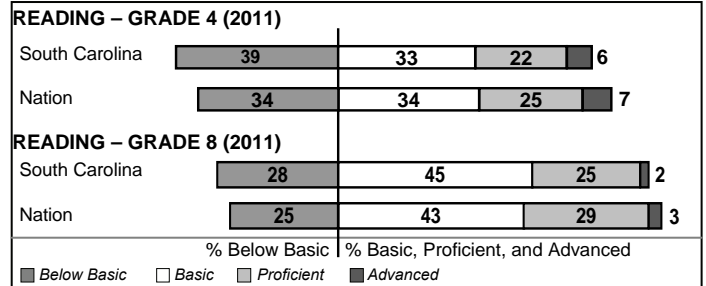

REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT

In Richland One we operate with one vision, one mission and one common purpose as evidenced by the many accomplishments made by our schools, students and staff during the 2012-2013 school year.

Here are just a few of our Points of Pride from the past year:

Richland One received an overall grade of "B" (89.6) on the new federal accountability report cards. Five of our elementary schools met the criteria for recognition as Reward Schools, ranking them among the top 5% of Title I schools in South Carolina based on their students' performance on the 2012 PASS (Palmetto Assessment of State Standards).

Our schools won 23 Palmetto Gold and Palmetto Silver Awards, the state's highest educational awards for student academic achievement and improvement.

The district had 14 National Merit and National Achievement Scholarship semifinalists, two U.S. Presidential Scholar candidates and 179 Richland One Academic All-Stars (a new district record).

South Kilbourne Elementary School was named a 2012 National Blue Ribbon School by the U.S. Department of Education, making it the second consecutive year a Richland One school was awarded the prestigious distinction. Gadsden Elementary was named a 2011 National Blue Ribbon School.

Three Richland One seniors were named Gates Millennium Scholars (the highest number in the state) and 317 middle-school students were honored as Richland One Middle School Scholars, South Carolina Junior Scholars and Duke TIP recipients (a new district record).

Twenty-four more Richland One teachers earned National Board certification, the highest credential available in the teaching profession. The district now has 312 National Board-certified teachers.

Our student-athletes won several individual state championships in swimming, wrestling and track, and four team state championships in basketball, baseball and golf – all while maintaining at least a "C" average as required by the district for participation in athletics and other co-curricular activities.

Last, but certainly not least, the Richland One Class of 2013 earned nearly \$53 million in scholarships and other financial aid. We know that the strong academic foundation our newest graduates received in Richland One will take them anywhere they want to go in pursuing their dreams.
