REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

Brashier Middle College Charter High School is driven to provide an exceptional environment and program for each student as they learn the content and skills needed to be successful in both college and careers. This year our graduates earned nearly 2000 college hours and \$2,500,000 in scholarships.

Our staff is committed to challenging themselves to gain new knowledge and skills that enable each of them to teach effectively. This year, our school adopted the TAP System, The System for Teacher and Student Advancement, for professional growth and evaluation. This approach focuses on the performance of our students and the supports we must develop to assist them. The staff meets weekly to learn new strategies, discuss student data, and design lessons and assessments. TAP is a school wide program that has already resulted in increased performance on the EOC exams and a decrease in the number of students requiring remediation.

To compliment this professional development, the Board of Directors created a new strategic plan emphasizing increased community relationships. As a charter school, we must educate the community about our program, student success, and needs. One example of this work was a series of career nights for parents and students. Our families had the opportunity to hear directly from employers in our community and have discussions about avenues to enter that field. Each of these nights was specifically designed for a career cluster allowing families to attend the event that met the interests of their student. This small group focus also allowed families to spend more time with these professionals.

Brashier Middle College Charter High School provides a unique environment that puts community first. This community includes our students, parents, and staff. Together, we can meet the needs of our students and bridge the gap to adulthood.
