Rock Hill School District's Applied Technology Center (ATC) provides Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs of study for any student enrolled at either Northwestern, Rock Hill, or South Pointe High School. ATC is a fully accredited school and offers career-based courses; such as, Pre-Engineering, Fundamentals of Teaching, Culinary Arts, Television Broadcasting and Production, Videography, Digital Art and Design, APP Development, Health Science Technologies, Graphics & Printing, Marketing & Advertising, Personal Finance, Computer Repair, Pharmacology, Architectural Drafting, Landscape Design, Electricity, Automotive Technology, as well as programs related to the Building and Construction industry. Exposure to these career-related programs provide students with both theory and practical experiences to help them make decisions regarding their future career path and post high school education plans. Making career decisions and related post-high school education plans should occur prior to high school graduation, rather than afterwards in order to create a seamless transition from school to work and/or college. Our goal is that every CTE student leaves high school with a clear understanding of what their personal interest and aptitude is in terms of their eventual career path, as well as the related education component to help them achieve their eventual career goals. In fact our school motto, "Gateway To The World" implies that our students are expected to be COLLEGE, WORK, and LIFE ready after completing CTE programs of study at the Applied Technology Center.
