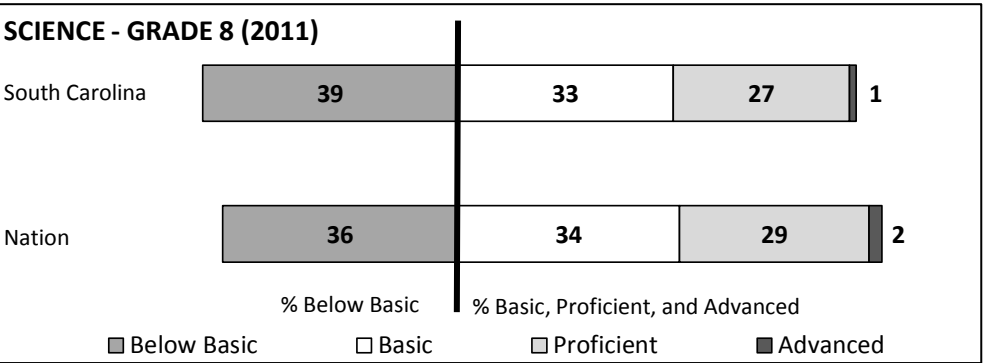
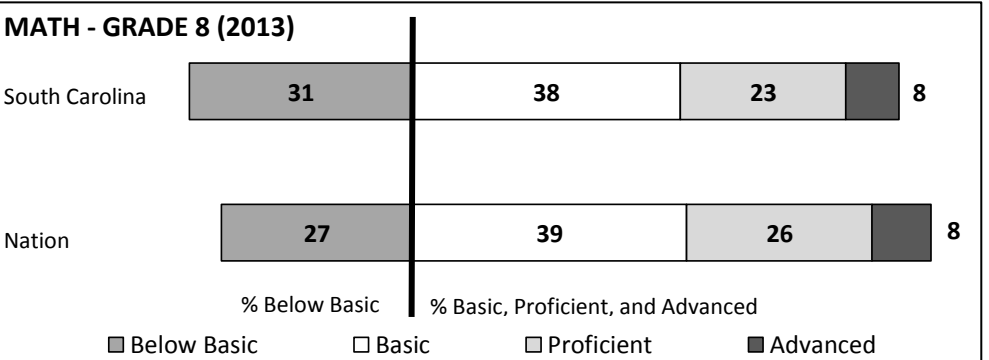
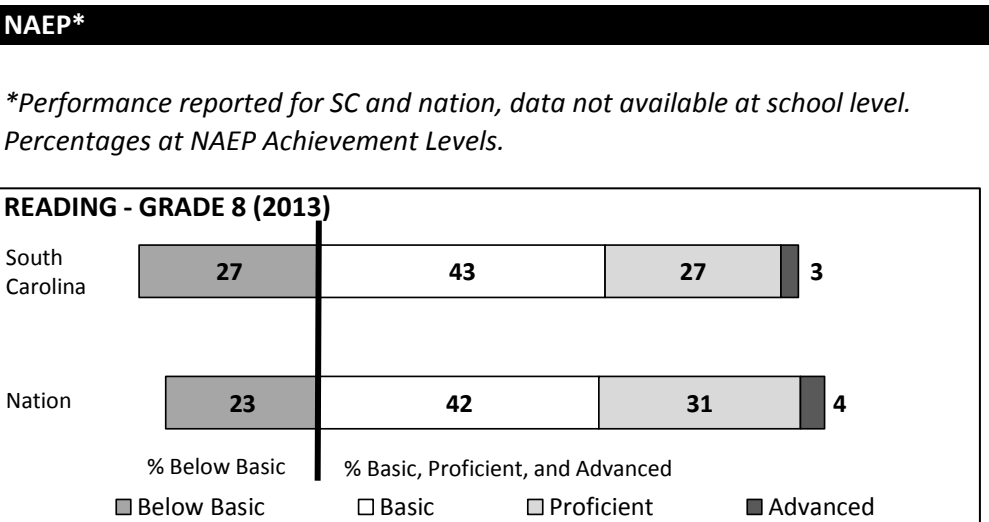

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REPORT OF PRINCIPAL AND SCHOOL  
IMPROVEMENT COUNCIL

During the 2013-2014 school year, we continued to empower our students with a challenging learning environment that encouraged high expectations for success. We continued to implement strategies, interventions, and instructional practices that were necessary and relevant to move our school academically. Our 2013 Annual School Report Card reflected an improvement in our school’s progress towards academic excellence. Additionally, our school received the Palmetto Silver Award for closing the achievement gap between subgroups of students for the second consecutive year. More importantly, we continued to improve on our passage rates on the End of Course and HSAP Assessments and continued to create a culture of high expectations for our students. The 2013-2014 graduating class consisted of 132 graduates, of which, thirty six were Honor Graduates, and forty qualified for a Life Scholarship. Additionally, we improved our four year graduation rate to 78%. The class of 2013-2014 also received \$4.2 million dollars in scholarships. Our school was designated as a Title I school for the 2013-2014 school year. The Title I Funding enabled our school to provide opportunities for students to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to meet challenging State Content Standards. The faculty and staff of Woodland High School are committed to developing life-long learners who will have a positive impact on our global world.
