ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION

SUMMARY OF THE CASE

The State Board of Education (State Board) considered this matter on November 21, 2025. In accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-370(c) (2020), § 59-5-10 (2020), and State Board Rule of Governance BBABA, the South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) requested that the Chair of the State Board summarily suspend the educator certificate of Jason Erik Keller, educator certificate 217907, as a result of his arrest for attempted sexual exploitation of a minor, first degree (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-15-395 (A)), two counts of criminal solicitation of a minor (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-15-342), and attempted criminal sexual conduct with a minor, second degree (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-03-655 (B)(1)).

The SCDE has reason to believe that, due to the serious nature of these allegations of misconduct, Mr. Keller may pose a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of students, who may be under his instruction and that emergency action is required. After considering the evidence presented by the SCDE, the Chair of the State Board finds that Mr. Keller's educator certificate shall be summarily suspended until a due process hearing is held and/or this matter is otherwise resolved. The SCDE is directed to serve notice on Mr. Keller of the summary suspension, as well as the possible suspension or revocation of his educator certificate.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Mr. Keller holds a South Carolina educator certificate and has over twenty-one years of educator experience. At the time of the incident, Mr. Keller was employed by as a non-

instructional staff member by Atlantic Collegiate Academy, a school within the Limestone Charter Association.

On or about January 14, 2025, Mr. Keller was arrested for attempted sexual exploitation of a minor, first degree (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-15-395 (A)), two counts of criminal solicitation of a minor (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-15-342), and attempted criminal sexual conduct with a minor, second degree (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-03-655 (B)(1)).

The SCDE has reason to believe that, due to the serious nature of this allegation of misconduct, Mr. Keller may pose a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of students who may be under his instruction, and that emergency action is required. After considering the evidence presented by the SCDE, the Chair of the State Board finds that Mr. Keller's educator certificate shall be summarily suspended until a due process hearing is held and/or this matter is otherwise resolved. The SCDE is directed to serve notice on Mr. Keller of the summary suspension, as well as the possible suspension or revocation of his educator certificate.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

"The South Carolina Board of Education may, for just cause, either revoke or suspend the certificate of any person." S.C. Code Ann. § 59-25-150 (2020); S.C. Code Ann. § 59-25-160 (2020). Just cause includes unprofessional conduct, crime against the law of this State, and evident unfitness for position for which employed. S.C. Code Ann. § 59-25-160 (2020); 24 S.C. Code Regs. 43-58 (2021). In accordance with S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-370(c) (2020), "If the agency finds that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and incorporates a finding to that effect in its order, summary suspension of a license may be ordered pending proceedings for revocation or other action." Pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. § 59-5-10 (2020) and State Board Rule of Governance BBABA, the Chair of the State Board finds that as a result of the allegations of Mr. Keller's unprofessional conduct, crime against the law of this State or the United States, and evident unfitness for the position for which employed, due to his arrest for attempted sexual exploitation of a minor, first degree (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-15-395 (A)),

two counts of criminal solicitation of a minor (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-15-342), and attempted criminal sexual conduct with a minor, second degree (S.C. Code of Laws Ann. § 16-03-655 (B)(1)), there is reason to believe Mr. Keller may pose a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of students and emergency action is required.

Accordingly, the educator certificate of Jason Erik Keller, certificate number 217907, is summarily suspended until a due process hearing is held and/or this matter is otherwise resolved. The SCDE is directed to serve notice on Mr. Keller of the summary suspension, as well as the possible suspension or revocation of his educator certificate.
