Powers and responsibilities of State Board of
Education

State Board Rule:

The State Board of Education recognizes the importance of providing recognition and praise for the positive things that are happening in South Carolina public schools. The Board realizes that it is impossible to formally grant recognition to all of the deserving programs and individuals at its monthly Board meetings and therefore creates a State Board of Education Certificate of Recognition that may be awarded by any member of the State Board of Education.

Any Board member may issue a State Board of Education Certificate of Recognition, which will be designed by the South Carolina Department of Education and available for all Board members. The certificates may be issued to recognize students, teachers, schools, districts, staff, businesses, volunteers, extracurricular programs, sports teams, and others.
