Constitutional and Statutory Provisions:

S.C. Code Ann. § 59-5-60(8) (2004):

The State Board of Education shall have the power to:

Appoint such committees and such members of committees as may be required or as may be desirable to carry out the orderly function of the Board;

State Board Rule:

Policy and Legislative Committee

Duties:

1. Upon the direction of the Board Chair, to review, recommend, and/or propose regulations governing the operation of the statewide system of public education which have not been assigned to one of the other standing committees of the Board.
2. To recommend policies necessary for achieving the goals of the Board.
3. To review and recommend rules of governance for the internal operation of the Board.
4. To review and recommend and/or propose needed changes in current school laws.
5. To review and inform the Board of the status of all significant legislation related to education as it is introduced in the General Assembly.
6. To review current and pending state and federal legislation related to education and recommend position statements to the Board.
7. To review schools and districts that do not make expected progress or comply with the recommendations made by the External Review Teams and make recommendations to the Board.
8. To review and consider other related items as determined by the Chair of the Board.
