Constitutional and Statutory Provisions:

S.C. Code Ann. § 59-5-60(8) (2004):

The State Board of Education shall have the power to:

Appoint such committees and such members of committees as may be required or as may be desirable to carry out the orderly function of the Board;

State Board Rule:

Education Professions Committee

Duties:

1. To review, recommend, and/or propose regulations, guidelines, and policies that relate to educator preparation, certification, alternative certification and preparation, evaluation, professional development, educator recruitment and retention.
2. To study the state system for educator preparation, certification, evaluation, professional development, recruitment and retention and to make appropriate recommendations to the Board.
3. To review the recommendations of the Professional Review Committee (PRC) regarding the accreditation of educator preparation units and their programs and to make subsequent recommendations to the Board.
4. To review and consider other related items as determined by the Chair of the Board.
