

STATE AND FEDERAL AID ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATION

Constitutional and Statutory Provisions:

State aid for such purposes as teachers' salary, supervision and overhead, maintenance and operation, and capital improvements are allocated to districts on the basis of enrollment or average daily attendance. (See §§ 59-21-10, et seq., 59-21-110, 59-21-120, 59-21-310, et seq., and §59-21-510, et seq., South Carolina Code.)

The State Superintendent has general responsibility for dispersing State aid. (See §59-3-30(2), South Carolina Code.)

State Board Rule:

Eligibility for State funding of public school programs shall be determined by the provisions set forth in State law and regulation, especially the Education Finance Act and the Education Improvement Act. (See ABB, State Board of Education Powers and Duties.)

Eligibility for federal funding of public school programs will be determined by Federal law and regulation.

The State Superintendent has general supervision over the management of all public school funds provided by the State and Federal governments.
