Constitutional and Statutory Provisions:

Pursuant to §59-5-90, South Carolina Code, the State Board of Education shall conduct surveys of existing public school facilities, set forth the needs for new construction and shall make rules and regulations for carrying out these duties. (See §§59-5-100, 59-5-110, and 59-5-120, South Carolina Code.)

Pursuant to section 59-5-100, South Carolina Code, as amended, the State Board of Education shall promote the improvement of the school system and its physical facilities. The State Board shall prescribe and promulgate reasonable rules and regulations to carry out these duties. (See §59-5-120, South Carolina Code.)

Section 59-144-120 of the South Carolina Code, requires the Board to develop guidelines for a uniform assessment of local districts' facilities needs and standardized cost allowances for estimating the cost of meeting those needs.

Section 59-144-130 of the South Carolina Code, requires the Board to report, every three (3) years to the General Assembly, each local school district's facilities needs for the next five (5) years.
