PURPOSE OF REPORT/REGULATION/ITEM

This item presents the recommendations for the Uniform Grading Procedure Task Force required by Act 204 of 2026.

CRITICAL FACTS

TIMELINE/REVIEW PROCESS

May 2026	Act 204, Public school grading practices, signed by the governor. Act 204 directs the State Board of Education to “establish a task force comprised of three superintendents, principals, teachers, representatives of public school boards each, and three high school students to evaluate potential revisions to the Uniform Grading Policy.”
Before June 2027	The task force shall report its findings to the State Board of Education. The task force shall make recommendations to the board for potential revisions in areas including, but not limited to, the use of term weighting in calculating final student grades, the method of awarding quality points on the basis of unique numeric final course averages when calculating student grade point averages, and the use of a 100-point grading scale. The State Board of Education shall consider the findings and adopt any updates to the Uniform Grading Policy.
