Precode File Transfer Errors for SC READY and EOCEP spring 2026:

If your district had student records coded in PowerSchool as Hispanic/Latino and/or Gifted and Talented for the EOCEP Fall/Winter 2025-26 administration, please be aware that these fields did not carry over into the precode file provided to DRC due to the state's transition to Ed-Fi. As a result, this information was not included in the district data files posted for the Fall/Winter 2025-26 administration. Please note that the missing Hispanic/Latino designation also impacted the federal reporting field contained within the data files.

Should you wish to resolve this, please contact Mary Voulgaris in the SCDE Office of Research and Data Analysis (mvoulgaris@ed.sc.gov, 803-734-3172), who can provide guidance on how to retrieve the missing PowerSchool data and incorporate it into your EOCEP Fall/Winter 2025–2026 district data.

The SCDE, ORDA, and DRC will verify that data for these fields are included in the Spring SC READY and EOCEP precode files so it can be uploaded into the Portal and included in the district data files following the Spring 2026 administration.

Unauthorized Websites Impersonating WIN Career Readiness System:

WIN has identified that if you enter the WIN Career Readiness System URL without the first or second “s” in “wincrsystem”, you will be directed to a malicious website unaffiliated with WIN Learning. This site will attempt to phish credentials to install malicious software. The malicious websites do contain keywords that make them appear related to our products; however, be assured that they are not associated with WIN Learning.

The correct WIN Career Readiness System domain is *wincrsystem.com.

The correct South Carolina assessment site URL is: <https://sc.wincrsystem.com>

Action Required:

1. Do **not** attempt to visit or test the suspicious websites.
2. Consider bookmarking the official WIN site to avoid navigation errors.
3. Consider creating a desktop shortcut for students to access WIN.
4. Work with your technology staff to block the malicious URL using district web content filter to prevent any access.
5. Ensure staff access WIN only through official links previously provided by WIN.
6. Share this information with relevant staff (technology coordinators, facilitators, and administrators).
