It does not expose students to secure test content and may be used multiple times.</p> <p>Using the OTT allows students to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Become familiar with the testing interface, navigation, and item types; • Practice using embedded tools (e.g., highlighting, cross-off tool, keypad entry, and calculators); and
