Number of Items Aligned by Standard for Each Subject and Grade

Explanation of the Table Categories

Items were evaluated by eight English language arts (ELA) and eight mathematics curriculum specialists who participated in the alignment study. After a virtual training, the curriculum specialists independently reviewed the items for their particular subject and grade span. The breakdown of specialists by grade band for each subject included: K-2 (2 specialists); 3-5 (2 specialists); 6-8 (4 specialists). The results of their review, by subject and grade level, are provided in the following tables.

Curriculum Associates provided the SCDE with a stratified, random sample of approximately 100 items per grade level from their item pool. The stratified proportional sample was based on a range of item difficulties and the breadth and depth of the standards for each subject across grade levels.

The *Number of Items Evaluated* indicates the total number of items that Curriculum Associates sent to the SCDE.

The *Number (Percent) Aligned* indicates the total number of items that the curriculum specialists rated as being aligned to a standard within South Carolina’s College and Career Ready Standards. The percentage of the total number of items evaluated by the curriculum specialists for each grade level is indicated within the parenthesis.

The *Number (Percent) Not Aligned* category indicates the number of items that were not aligned to a standard/indicator within the particular grade level. Items that were categorized as “not aligned” may be aligned to standards in another grade level or the items may test a skill that is not included within the South Carolina College and Career Ready Standards.

The *Standards Not Evaluated* category indicates the specific standards, assessed by the SCDE, for which no aligned items were received from the publisher.
