Test Design Summary

- This blueprint is for assessing the *2024 South Carolina College-and-Career-Ready ELA Standards*.
- The assessment is not timed.
- The assessment is administered in two sessions: Reading and Writing.
- The assessment consists of 55 items.
- There will be an additional 8-10 embedded field test items across both sessions.
- Test items cover a range of cognitive complexity levels and a range of difficulty levels.

Text-Dependent Writing (TDW)

The TDW item is an extended response item scored with a holistic rubric. The rubric has two traits. The point range of Trait One is 1 (lowest) to 4 (highest). The point range of Trait Two is 0 (lowest) to 2 (highest). The maximum number of points for the TDW item is 6. Depth of Knowledge (DOK) Range

The table outlines the minimum and maximum percentages of items at each DOK level on the test.
