2021 Teacher Checklist

Use this checklist to help you stay on track and make the most of the KRA this year!

BEFORE the KRA Administration Window

☐ Complete KRA Teacher Training

Teachers NEW to the KRA: To become certified to administer the KRA, you must attend the full teacher training and earn a passing score of 80% or higher on a simulation exercise and content assessment. Your district data manager will setup your account in the KReady online system before your training begins.

Teachers EXPERIENCED with the KRA: Every year, you must complete an online refresher module and download your refresher certificate.

☐ Make a Plan

Plan for *when* and *how* you will administer the KRA. Refer to resources such as the **Item Delivery Options** handout and **KRA Throughout the Day** handout to help you think about how you can incorporate the KRA into your curriculum, schedule, and class structure. Consider using the KRA App to deliver a subset of the items.

DURING the KRA Administration Window

☐ Assess Your Students

Administer all KRA items and enter your scores into the KReady online system within your district's administration window.

☐ Check Out the KRA Newsletter

You can generate a Domain Data Export report **as soon as you begin entering scores** into KReady. This report provides the raw data you have entered into the system and can be used to plan for instruction.

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☐ Generate ISRs and Share KRA Results with Families

As soon as you have entered all the scores for an individual student, you can generate an Individual Student Report (ISR) to share with families. This report can only be generated once all 50 item scores have been entered for a student.

☐ Attend a KRA Reports & Data Training

Once you have completed administration of the KRA, what's next? The KRA provides useful information to identify the individual strengths and needs of each student -- and most importantly, guide the next steps in instruction.
