



## Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA) Reports

Below is a list of reports available to you, as a teacher, within the Ready for Kindergarten Online system for the Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA).

### During and After the Administration Window

During and after the administration window, you have access to individual assessment item data in three formats for your students.

- (1) Individual Student Item Results – a printable PDF document of an individual student’s scores by item. It provides the item and scoring information along with the student’s score for each of the assessment items. This is available on the KRA overview screen, with a button labeled ‘Item Results’ next to each student’s name.

This document can be printed by student, showing scores for all items or just selected items. This report could be shared with parents and families in an effort to dig into the assessment and show parents specific examples of what the student is doing well as well as items where the student needs targeted instruction.

- (2) Class Item Results – a printable PDF document of your class roster with scores by item. It provides the item and scoring information along with all students’ scores for each of the assessment items. This is available on the KRA overview screen and can be accessed by clicking the blue ‘Class Item Results’ button at the top.

This report allows you to analyze your class by individual assessment item to see how each student scored on an item. Just like the individual student item results reports, this report includes the scoring information for each assessment item so you can look at individual items to see how your class is performing.

- (3) Class CSV Export – a Microsoft Excel file of your class roster with scores by item. This report can be generated and queued by clicking the red ‘Class CSV Export’ button at the top. After you have queued the report, click on the blue ‘Exports’ button to download and view the file.

Then, once the spreadsheet has been opened, it can be sorted and filtered to meet your needs. For example, you can sort an item by score to see how groups of students scored. The students can then receive focused instruction based on the grouping.

**Teacher and Parent/Family (After the Administration Window)**

After the administration window ends, your account in the Ready for Kindergarten Online system is populated with an Individual Student Report (ISR) next to each student's name. The ISR is a multi-page PDF document that you can view and/or download and print. The ISR is available in English as well as multiple languages. The pages within the ISR include the following:

- (1) The first page provides background information about the KRA; what it is, how it is used, and an explanation of how scores are calculated.
- (2) The second page is the student's score page. It provides an overall KRA score and a performance level descriptor for that student's overall score. In addition, it provides scores for four domains (Mathematics, Language and Literacy, Social Foundations, Physical Development and Well-Being) and indicates whether the student is above or below the demonstrating readiness line based on the standard error of measurement for the student's specific domain/area.
- (3) The third and fourth pages are additional resources and information specific for parents and families. This applies to Maryland only.
