

SC READY Science Grade 4 Test Blueprint 2025-26

Test Design Summary

- This blueprint is for the assessment of the [South Carolina College- and Career-Ready Science Standards 2021](#).
- The assessment is not timed.
- The assessment consists of 45 test items.
- There will be 7 additional embedded field test items: one stimulus set with three related items and four stand-alone items.
- Test items cover a range of cognitive complexity levels and a range of difficulty levels.
- The test consists of machine scored items including selected response, evidence-based reasoning, technology-enhanced, and technology-enhanced constructed-response.
- The test is one section.
- The test includes three stimulus sets that provide a context for three related items.
