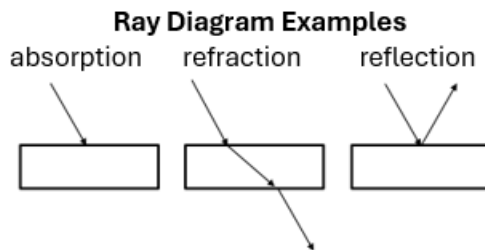


Grade 6 Revisions/ Additions to Assessment Specifications for 2026-2027

For state assessment purposes:

- Students are expected to know that refraction is the bending of a light ray, caused by a change in speed.
- Students are expected to develop and use ray diagrams representing the behaviors of light: absorption, refraction, reflection, and transmission as it interacts with opaque, translucent, and transparent media.

Assessable Organ Systems, Components, Functions, and Interactions

- Added to circulatory system:
 - Works with the skeletal system to move blood cells made in bones throughout the body
- Added to the skeletal system:
 - Works with the circulatory system by making blood cells that carry oxygen throughout the body
